INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Overseas Network's privacy policy.

Overseas Network respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data. This privacy policy will inform you as to how we look after your personal data (including when you simply visit our website regardless of where you visit it from) and tell you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

1. IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND WHO WE ARE

Purpose of this privacy policy

This privacy policy aims to give you information on how Overseas Network collects and processes your personal data through your use of this website, including any data you may provide to us (through this website or otherwise) when you sign up to our newsletter, register an account, request a contact or call back, register your interest in one of our products or services, or purchase anything. This website is not intended for children and we do not knowingly collect data relating to children (being a person under the age of 13 for the purpose of this privacy policy).

It is important that the personal data we hold about you is accurate and current. Please keep us informed if your personal data changes during your relationship with us.

Third-party links

We do not control these third-party websites and are not responsible for their privacy statements. When you leave our website, we encourage you to read the privacy policy of every website you visit.

2. THE DATA WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU

Personal data, or personal information, means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

We may collect, use, store and transfer different kinds of personal data about you which we have grouped together as follows (please note that depending on your arrangement with us, we may collect some or all of these different kinds of personal data about you):

- **Identity Data** includes first name, maiden name, last name, username or similar identifier, title, date of birth, country of residence, language and gender.
- Contact Data includes billing address, delivery address, e-mail address and telephone numbers.
- Financial Data includes bank account and payment card details. Please note that whilst we may in limited circumstances receive payment card details from you, we do not store payment card details after payment has been made by you and received by us.
- Transaction Data includes details about payments to and from you and other details of products and services you have purchased from us.
- Technical Data includes internet protocol (IP) address, your login data, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform and other technology on the devices you use to access this website.
- **Profile Data** includes your username and password, purchases or orders made by you, your interests, preferences, feedback, and survey responses.
- Usage Data includes information about how you use our website, products and services.
- Marketing and Communications Data includes your preferences in receiving marketing from us and our third parties and your communication preferences.

We also collect, use, and share Aggregated Data or Pseudonymised Data such as statistical or demographic data for any purpose. Aggregated Data or Pseudonymised Data may be derived from your personal data but is not considered personal data in law as this data does not directly or indirectly reveal your identity. For example, we may aggregate your Usage Data to calculate the percentage of users accessing a specific website feature. However, if we combine or connect Aggregated Data or Pseudonymised Data with your personal data so that it can directly or indirectly identify you, we will treat the combined data as personal data which will only be used in accordance with this privacy policy.

If you require disabled or assisted access to any stadium or have special dietary requirements, you may provide, and we may collect and store **Special Categories of Personal Data** in the form of any disabilities or health conditions you may have. Apart from this we do not collect any other **Special Categories of Personal Data** about you (this includes details about your race or ethnicity, religious or philosophical beliefs, sex life, sexual orientation, political opinions, trade union membership, information about your health and genetic and biometric data). Nor do we collect any information about criminal convictions and offences.

If you fail to provide personal data

Where we need to collect personal data by law, or under the terms of a contract we have with you and you fail to provide that data when requested, we may not be able to perform the contract we have or are trying to enter into with you (for example, we may need a delivery address to provide you with goods). In this case, we may have to terminate our contract with you, but we will notify you if this is the case at the time.

3. HOW IS YOUR PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED?

We use different methods to collect data from and about you, including through:

- **Direct interactions.** You may give us your Identity, Contact and Financial Data by filling in forms or by corresponding with us by post, phone, e-mail, support by live chat or otherwise. This includes personal data you provide when you:
 - apply for or purchase our products or services;
 - create an account on our website;
 - subscribe to our service or publications;
 - request marketing information to be sent to you;
 - enter a competition or survey;
 - If you chat with us on our live chat service; or
 - give us some feedback.
- Automated technologies or interactions. As you interact with our website, we may automatically collect Technical Data about your location, equipment, browsing actions and patterns. We collect this personal data by using cookies, server logs and other similar technologies. We may also receive Technical Data about you if you visit other websites employing our cookies.
 - We receive Technical Data from the following parties including a) analytics and search information providers such as Google; b) advertising networks such as Google or Facebook; c) hosting providers such as Amazon Web Services.
- Contact, Financial and Transaction Data from providers of technical, payment and delivery services.
- Support by live chat. If you chat with us on our live chat service, you will be sharing your e-mail address with us for the purposes of sending you a transcript as well as identifying yourself to our support team. This is necessary to provide our service to you. In addition to this information, our live chat system will place a cookie in your browser which will persist until you quit your browser. We may also use records of live chats for staff training, to make sure we can offer you the best possible service.

Retention: We retain transcripts of all live chats (including name & contact details of the website visitor) for the purpose of providing service to you.

4. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We will only use your personal data when the law allows us to. Most commonly, we will use your personal data in the following circumstances:

- Where we need to perform the contract we are about to enter into or have entered into with you or
 <u>deliver the corresponding goods and service</u>. Performance of Contract means processing your data
 and sharing your data with third parties where it is necessary for the performance of a contract to
 which you are a party or to take steps at your request before entering into such a contract or
 reservation.
- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and your interests and
 fundamental rights do not override those interests. Legitimate Interest means the interest of our
 business in conducting and managing our business to enable us to give you the best service/product
 and the best and most secure experience.
- Where we need to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation. Comply with a legal or regulatory obligation means processing your personal data where it is necessary for compliance with a legal or regulatory obligation that we are subject to.

We do NOT sell your personal data.

Generally, we do not rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your personal data; other than we may in certain circumstances rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your personal data in relation to sending direct marketing communications to you via e-mail (if you consent to them doing so). Marketing

We strive to provide you with choices regarding certain personal data uses, particularly around marketing and advertising. We have established the following personal data control mechanisms:

Promotional offers from us

Cookies

Change of purpose

We will only use your personal data for the purposes for which we collected it, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose.

Please note that we may process your personal data without your knowledge or consent, in compliance with the above rules, where this is required or permitted by law.

5. DISCLOSURES OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We may have to share your personal data with the parties set out below for the purposes set out in the table in paragraph 4 above.

- <u>Internal Third Parties</u>. Other companies in the Overseas Network group of companies or affiliated companies who provide IT and system administration services and travel and entertainment products and services.
- External Third Parties. Including the following:
- o Event or tournament organisers (including but not limited to FIFA).
- o MATCH Hospitality AG, the provider of In-stadium hospitality products and services.
- o Event or tournament organisers (including but not limited to FIFA).
- o Travel and entertainment providers such as airlines, hoteliers, transportation companies, car rentals, restaurants, clubs, concierges, security providers to provide the product or service you have requested.
- o Professional advisers or investigators acting as processors or joint controllers including lawyers, bankers, auditors and insurers who provide consultancy, banking, legal, insurance and accounting services.
- Service providers acting as processors who provide payment, IT and system administration services, with whom we need to share your information in order to obtain payment from you or to provide the product or service you have requested.
- o Law enforcement agencies or local authorities, or security services for the purposes of event security and safety.
- o Relevant tax authorities, regulators and other authorities acting as processors or joint controllers who require reporting of processing activities in certain circumstances.
- o Media buying and web agencies including organisations managing or purchasing paid search keywords or display advertising.
- o Companies delivering goods or services to you (in cases where we act as an authorised reseller, sales agent, or travel agency).
- o We may share your details with companies who provide us with communication services such as a live chat or e-mail providers.
- Third parties to whom we may choose to sell, transfer, or merge parts of our business or our assets. Alternatively, we may seek to acquire other businesses or merge with them. If a change happens to our business, then the new owners may use your personal data in the same way as set out in this privacy policy.

We require all third parties to respect the security of your personal data and to treat it in accordance with the law. We do not allow our third-party service providers to use your personal data for their own

purposes and only permit them to process your personal data for specified purposes and in accordance with our instructions.

6. CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS

This section applies only to California residents.

6.1 CPRA Compliance for California Residents

6.1.1 Right to Know

6.1.3 Right to Opt-Out of Sale

As a California resident, you have the right to opt-out of the sale of your personal information. We do not sell your personal information, and as such, no opt-out process is necessary.

6.1.4 Right to Non-Discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising your rights under the CPRA. This includes denying goods or services, charging different prices or rates, providing a different level of quality, or suggesting that you may receive different treatment for exercising your rights.

6.1.5 Authorized Agent

You have the right to designate an authorized agent to make requests on your behalf. To do so, you must provide written authorization for the agent to act on your behalf and verify your identity directly with us.

Your California Privacy Rights California Civil Code Section 1798.83 permits California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of personal information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes.

7. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

We do not knowingly collect, use, or disclose personal information from children under the age of 13. If we are made aware we have collected personal information from a child under 13 years old in a manner that is inconsistent with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, we will delete this information as soon as possible.

8. INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

We share your personal data within the MATCH Hospitality group.

Your personal data information may be processed in the United States and in Switzerland and may also be stored and used elsewhere depending on the location of the MATCH Hospitality group company or service provider who is permitted to access such information under these rules (and such locations may include countries which may not afford the same level of protection of such data as the country from which you provided the information).

Some of our external third parties are based outside the European Economic Area (EEA) so their processing of your personal data will involve a transfer of data outside the EEA.

Whenever we transfer your personal data out of the United States or the EEA, we ensure a similar degree of protection is afforded to it by seeking to implement at least one of the following safeguards:

- We will only transfer your personal data to countries that have been deemed to provide an adequate level of protection for personal data by the European Commission. For further details, see European Commission: Adequacy of the protection of personal data in non-EU countries.
- Where we use certain service providers, we may use specific contracts approved by the European Commission which give personal data the same protection it has in Europe. For further details, see European Commission: Model contracts for the transfer of personal data to third countries.
- Where we use providers based in the US, we may transfer data to them if they are part of the Privacy Shield which requires them to provide similar protection to personal data shared between Europe and the US. For further details, see European Commission: EU-US Privacy Shield.

9. DATA SECURITY

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal data from being accidentally lost, used, or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered, or disclosed. In addition, we limit access to your personal data to those employees, agents, contractors and other third parties who have a business need to know. They will only process your personal data on our instructions and they are subject to a duty of confidentiality. However, the Internet is an open system and we cannot guarantee that unauthorised third parties will never be able to defeat those measures or use your personal information for improper purposes.

We have put in place procedures to deal with any suspected personal data breach and will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

If you communicate with us by e-mail, you should note that the secrecy of Internet e-mail is uncertain. By sending sensitive or confidential e-mail messages or information which are not encrypted you accept the risk of such uncertainty and possible lack of confidentiality over the Internet.

10. DATA RETENTION

How long will you use my personal data for?

We will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements and/or, where you have provided your consent, future marketing, and other related communications with you.

To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, we consider the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorised use or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which we process your personal data and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements.

By law we have to keep basic information about our customers (including Contact, Identity, Financial and Transaction Data) for up to six years after they cease being customers for tax purposes.

In some circumstances you can ask us to delete your data (please see Request erasure below for further information).

In some circumstances we may anonymise your personal data (so that it can no longer be associated with you) for research or statistical purposes in which case we may use this information indefinitely without further notice to you.

11. YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

Under certain circumstances, you have rights under data protection laws in relation to your personal data. You have the right to:

- Access my Data. This enables you to receive a copy of the personal data we hold about you and to check that we are lawfully processing it.
- Request correction of the personal data that we hold about you. This enables you to have any incomplete or inaccurate data we hold about you corrected (though we may need to verify the accuracy of the new data you provide to us).
- Delete My data. This enables you to ask us to delete or remove personal data where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it. You also have the right to ask us to delete or remove your personal data where you have successfully exercised your right to object to processing (see below), where we may have processed your information unlawfully or where we are required to erase your personal data to comply with local law. Note, however, that we may not always be able to comply with your request of erasure for specific legal reasons which will be notified to you, if applicable, at the time of your request.
- Withdraw consent at any time where we are relying on consent to process your personal data. However, this will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before you withdraw your consent. If you withdraw your consent, we may not be able to provide certain products or services to you or fulfil our contractual obligations. We will advise you if this is the case at the time you withdraw your consent.

12.6 Authorized Agent

You have the right to designate an authorized agent to make requests on your behalf. To do so, you must provide written authorization for the agent to act on your behalf and verify your identity directly with us.

No fee usually required

You will not have to pay a fee to access your personal data (or to exercise any of the other rights). However, we may charge a reasonable fee if your request is clearly unfounded, repetitive or excessive.

What we may need from you

We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and ensure your right to access your personal data (or to exercise any of your other rights). This is a security measure to ensure that personal data is not disclosed to any person who has no right to receive it. We may also contact you to ask you for further information in relation to your request to speed up our response.

Time limit to respond

We try to respond to all legitimate requests within one month. Occasionally it may take us longer than a month if your request is particularly complex or you have made a number of requests. In this case, we will notify you and keep you updated.
